Vintage 2019

A year with a cold spring and a warm summer surprised us with its combination of potency, freshness, and intensity.

Spring rains and cold weather resulted in a late bud break and flowering, and the yield was affected by October frosts. The conditions changed abruptly in January, however, and the hot, dry summer enabled the grapes to continue ripening for harvest during the first two weeks of April, resulting in a wine with excellent concentration and fruit intensity.

Violet-red in color and very intense on the nose, with aromas of cherries, raspberries, blueberries, roses, hibiscus, and violets. The palate is fresh and long, with juicy acidity and subtle spice notes.

A wine with fine, silky tannins, vibrant freshness, and tremendous fruit intensity.

Vinification

- 100% hand harvested
- 100% wild fermentation and 7% whole cluster
- Aged for 11 months in French barrels. 18% new 300 lts barrels
- Harvest date: 5th to 12th of April
- Production: 830 cases
